The licensee named above is authorised to sell liquor at the licensed premises described above, in accordance with the Liquor Control Act 1988 ("the Act"). The licensee must comply with all requirements and conditions imposed by the Act, any conditions or authorisations published by notice under s 31 of the Act, and any conditions or requirements set out below. The licence continues in force until surrendered or cancelled under the Act.

EXTENDED TRADING PERMITS

The following extended trading permits have been granted under s 60 of the Act. The authorisation to trade pursuant to the licence is modified accordingly.

TRADING HOURS AND CONDITIONS

TRADING HOURS

The permitted trading hours are those prescribed in s 98(1) of the Act for a hotel licence.

TRADING CONDITIONS

1. The licensee is authorised to sell and supply liquor in accordance with the provisions of s 41 of the Act as it relates to a tavern licence.
2. The sale and supply of packaged liquor for consumption off the premises is prohibited.
3. Music or entertainment at the premises must be at a level that permits conversation to occur.
4. A full meal menu must be available at all times. In addition, the kitchen must be open and food service staff must be available at all times liquor is sold and supplied to patrons.
5. All liquor is to be served by way of table service only.
6. No stools are permitted at the bar.

7. Except during pre-arranged functions, seating for at least 220 patrons must be provided at all times. The seating areas consist of the internal and external alfresco area.
8. A range of light liquor products must be available at all times.
9. The advertising of liquor at the premises is prohibited, with the exception of liquor that is on display and on the menu.
10. Spirits are not to be sold or supplied in non-standard measures (that is, no more than 30ml of spirits is permitted in any vessel).
11. No liquor is to be sold or supplied by virtue of their emotive title and known as 'laybacks', 'shots', 'shooters', 'test tubes', 'jelly shots', 'blasters' or 'bombs'.
12. No liquor is to be supplied with energy drinks.
(For the purposes of this condition energy drinks has the same meaning as formulated caffeinated beverage within Australia New Zealand Food Standards Code with a composition of 145mg/l of caffeine or greater).
13. A CCTV video surveillance system must be installed and operational until 30 mins after trading ceases. It is expected that this system will record continuous images of the alfresco area (includes all licensed outdoor areas), the internal dining area and the entrances and exits to the premises. Images recorded via the CCTV system must be retained for twenty-eight (28) days (or such period as the Director of Liquor Licensing specifies) and must be made available for viewing or removal by the Police or other persons authorised by the Director.

ENTERTAINMENT CONDITION

(a) A person resorting to, or on the premises, including the licensee or manager, or an employee or agent of the licensee or manager, shall not:

- i. be immodestly or indecently dressed on the licensed premises, and/or
- ii. take part in, undertake or perform any activity or entertainment on the licensed premises in a lewd or indecent manner.

(b) The licensee or manager, or an employee or agent of the licensee or manager, is prohibited from:

- i. exhibiting or showing, or causing, suffering or permitting to be exhibited or shown, on the licensed premises any "R 18+", "X 18+" or "RC" classified film or computer game or "Category 1 – Restricted" or "Category 2 – Restricted" publication, or extract therefrom; or
- ii. causing, suffering or permitting any person employed, engaged or otherwise contracted to undertake any activity or perform any entertainment on the licensed premises to be immodestly or indecently dressed on the licensed premises; or
- iii. causing, suffering or permitting any person to take part in, undertake or perform any activity or entertainment on the licensed premises in a lewd or indecent manner.

(c) In this condition "licensed premises" includes any premises, place or area:

- i. which is appurtenant to the licensed premises; or
- ii. in respect of which an extended trading permit granted to the licensee is for the time being in force, but does not include any part of the premises which is reserved for the private use of the licensee, manager or employees of the licensee and to which the public does not have access.

COMPLIANCE WITH HARM MINIMISATION POLICY

The licensee has lodged a copy of the House Management Policy, Code of Conduct and Management Plan developed for these premises in accordance with the Harm Minimisation Policy. These documents must be retained on the licensed premises and produced to any Authorised Officer if required.

This licence takes effect from **27 September 2019**.
